DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:
DEFENSE PRIORITIES AND
ALLOCATIONS SYSTEM

I. Purpose

This document delegates certain authorities under the Defense Priorities and Allocations System (DPAS) Delegation 4 to: the Deputy Administrator; Deputy Administrator for National Preparedness and Protection; Associate Administrator, Mission Support; U.S. Fire Administrator; Regional Administrators; Federal Insurance and Mitigation Administrator; Associate Administrator, Operations; and the Federal Coordinating Officers.

II. Delegation

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency by Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Delegation Number 9001 and subject to the guidance and direction of the Director of the Office of Policy and Program Analysis (OPPA), I hereby delegate to the following the authority to place "DO" priority-rated contracts and orders, as provided in the DPAS Regulations and DPAS Delegation 4, in support of DHS Approved Programs, as listed in Schedule 1 of 15 CFR Part 700: the Deputy Administrator; Deputy Administrator for National Preparedness and Protection; Associate Administrator, Mission Support; U.S. Fire Administrator; Regional Administrators; Federal Insurance and Mitigation Administrator; Associate Administrator, Operations; and the Federal Coordinating Officers. The Director of OPPA shall provide guidance, procedures, and coordination for the functions and duties assigned to the Administrator pursuant to DPAS Delegation 4.

III. Re-delegation


Unless re-delegation is otherwise prohibited by law or regulation, the authority to place "DO" priority-rated contracts and orders delegated herein may be re-delegated in writing by the officials listed in section II to appropriate subordinates.
