Use the following checklist to assess the school's current level of safety related to prevention and intervention efforts. If an element is in place, check YES. If changes need to be made, check IMPROVE. If the element is not in place, check NO.

11. Adequate suicide prevention support systems are in place for students.					
12. The school has implemented a character education program in accordance with the State code.
